



Northern Adventure Cruise Sample Itinerary

Thursday:

At 4.30pm meet at Café du Village located in the main street of Port Vila. Here you will complete any last minute paperwork while you sample some of the local brew or maybe grab a glass of fine French champagne. Once all the formalities have been completed you will be transported to our vessel Silent One which will be your home for the next 6 nights.

Friday:

Wake up in beautiful Havannah Harbour and it's time for your morning swim if you are up to it. Once everyone has finished their sumptuous cooked breakfast, we will up-anchor and cruise to Nguna. This is the site of an extinct volcano and is where we'll stay for the rest of the day. For the energetic, a walk up the Volcano is a mist as the views are simply breathtaking. For the water babies we will transport you in our inflatables to Meyric's wall, an awesome snorkelling site. Those that just want to totally chill out head for the beach or pull up a chair on the sun deck of Silent One.

Saturday:

Awake in the wilds of Tongoa and it's time for a morning snorkel. Don't miss this one, as it will be simply breathtaking. Imagine a sheer underwater wall drop-off boasting over 50m of visibility, throw in amazing large coral fans, massive schools of fish and a few sharks and you have the morning swim to beat all morning swims! To get to the site we will transport you on our two 5m inflatables. This swim is not for the faint-hearted, but it is an awesome buzz. Around midday, certified SCUBA divers will have the opportunity to see Tongoa wall from down below. This is a world-class dive and not to be missed. For the non-diver there will be fishing from our inflatables or more snorkelling. In the late afternoon, it's off to the local village to witness some unique local custom dances and sample some local food & Kava (the strongest in the South Pacific).

Sunday:

The morning is spent cruising the coast of Epi Island. By lunch time we are anchored inside the picturesque Lamén Bay. It's time for a snorkel with the tame Dugongs and huge resident turtles. The late afternoon is spent on a kayak tour around Lamén Island where we'll also check out the black sand beaches. The evening will be spent anchored in Lamén Bay where you can take in the amazing sight of the active volcano on Parma Island.

Monday:

The Maskeley Islands just south of Malekula are an idyllic place. Imagine several small islands with palm trees, beautiful beaches and reef all around. Throw in unique culture and amazing calm, clear water and you have your own private paradise. Go for a ride in one of our inflatables or just jump on a sea kayak and paddle from island to island. For those who want to totally chill out we will send you off to your own private island beach with a sun umbrella and a few cold drinks. Don't forget your favourite book and swimmers. If even that sound too energetic, just pull up a chair on the sun deck of Silent One.



In the evening we will take you over to Maskeleyn Village where you will be greeted as royalty. Witness local custom dances and listen to the string band.

Tuesday:

The morning is spent on a guided kayak tour of the Maskeleyn Islands and some of her hidden secret river mouths, where we'll paddle through the mangroves and on into the jungle. The afternoon will be spent cruising the coast of Malekula while on our way to Santo.

As with all our cruises, the last night aboard is party night!!

Wednesday:

The bad news is that we'll be back in port, and after breakfast it's time for us to say our farewells. The good news is that you'll have some amazing memories to take with you. Have a safe trip home, and maybe we'll see you again on this or one of our other adventure cruises.

Adventure Cruise Activity facilities

Snorkeling gear, Sea Kayaks, and diving equipment for certified divers is available throughout each cruise. Any certified divers will be offered a daily dive. Silent One's inflatable tenders are always available to ferry people to and from beaches and activity locations. Each day we run an escorted morning swim and walking or running activity. There is a limited supply of hand weights available on the vessel for those who miss the gym.
